

Older people can now make an appointment to get vaccinated against Corona.

Elderly people in Kalmar County are now starting to get vaccinated. But you must make an appointment. First out to make their appointments are people aged 77 and older. Everyone else must wait.

Everyone who wants to get vaccinated against Corona (COVID-19) must make an appointment. But right now, only those aged 77 and over, can make their booking. When they are vaccinated the next group can make an appointment.

Vaccination is good

When vaccinated you are protected from getting ill. But you also protect others. If many people are vaccinated, the virus will not find anyone to infect. Then the Corona pandemi will end.

In a pandemic, everyone must help each other. The more people who get vaccinated, the faster society can become more normal again.

Here is how to find out when it is time for your age group:

1. Visit the web page 1177.se.

It tells what age can be booked right now. (The information is in Swedish).



Aim your mobile camera at the QR-code.

2. Or: Call your health centre

and ask when it is time.



Aim your mobile camera at the QR-code. Scroll down until you find your health centre.

If you cannot figure out the phone number: call the switchboard at Region Kalmar County 0480-840 00. They will connect you to the health centre.

How to book an appointment

If you have a Swedish personal identity number and can speak Swedish, you should preferably use the website 1177.se for booking. Since you don't need a Bank Id for booking, you can ask someone to help you.

If you do not have a personal identity number you cannot make an appointment for vaccination online. Instead, call your health centre directly.

Region Kalmar County has sent a letter

If you are elderly, you probably already have received a letter in Swedish from Region Kalmar County. It contains information about vaccine and vaccination. Save the letter if you can ask someone who reads Swedish to help you do your booking.



How to book on mobile or computer

1. Visit 1177.se. Chose your health centre

Aim your mobile camera
at the QR-code.

(If you have a mobile phone: use the QR-code)

2. Under "Våra e-tjänster", click on "Boka tid för vaccination mot covid-19."
3. Choose "Syfte för besök", specify your priority group
4. Choose whether you make an appointment for one, ore two people (If you are a couple where both are 65 or older, you can make a joint appointment).
5. Find a suitable time in the calendar that appears.
6. Choose language, Swedish or English, in the upper right corner.
7. Fill in your personal information (at "Personuppgifter")
8. Fill in a health declaration "Hälsodeklaration" (or two, if you are a couple) and click "Spara"
9. Click the box to confirm the time "Bekräftelse av tid" and click "Samtyck" to consent.

Important: Windows Explorer web browser does not work. Use another browser

How to call your health centre for booking

- Find contact information for your health centre at 1177.se
- When they answer: select touch-tone option 3.
- Leave a voicemail message – leave your name and your phone number.
- They will get back to you within a week to book your appointment.

Note! VACCINATION IS ALWAYS FREE OF CHARGE. If someone calls and ask you to pay for the vaccine or ask you to hand over your Bank Id, that person is trying to fool you. Hang up the phone!

NOTE:

- ☛ If you have already received a vaccination against COVID-19, you should not make an appointment.
- ☛ If you take the medicine "Waran", you must make an appointment for blood tests one week before you are vaccinated.
