

NEW! Corona-test new requirement for entering Sweden

Foreign citizens wishing to travel to Sweden must be tested for corona (COVID-19). The test must be negative and not older than 48 hours. This does not apply to persons under the age of 18, to persons living in Sweden or to those working in certain professions.

It is still forbidden for persons outside the EEA* to travel into Sweden. The same applies for United Kingdom, Denmark, and Norway. In the past – commuters (persons living on one side of the border and working on the other) could enter, but now the rules are getting tougher for them as well.

They must also show negative test-results.

Swedish citizens are always allowed to enter the country. But you should test yourself immediately after arrival, then after five days again. It is important to stay at home until you have received an answer to the test.

Everyone from preschool age to older must be tested when returning to Sweden.

Police and staff from other authorities help controlling the border.

Right now, Kalmar County Council is vaccinating elderly people and health care staff. In mid-February, everyone aged 80 and older will receive a letter inviting them to vaccination. Shortly after, everyone who is 70-80 years gets their letter. At the beginning of March, everyone aged 65-69 will be next in turn.

The letter informs about how to make an appointment for vaccination.

Kalmar County is now second best in Sweden when it comes to vaccinating the population. To learn more about what it means to get vaccinated, the Public Health Agency of Sweden has produced information. It says about who gets the vaccination, how it is done, what to do if you have any diseases, how it differs between younger and older persons, and much more.
