

Corona is still spreading

The pandemic is not over. After the summer, the infection increases again in Kalmar County. Now the Delta variant dominates and it infects much more easily.

There are still 38,000 people in Kalmar County who have not been vaccinated yet. The Infection Control Physician, Lisa Labbé Sandelin says that the most important thing you can do now, is to get vaccinated.

Get vaccinated with two doses

It is important to get vaccinated with two doses. That gives you a better protection that lasts longer. You also get a good protection from getting seriously ill. Everyone who is vaccinated also helps to stop the pandemic and helps the hospitals from taking care of a large number of seriously ill persons.

Everyone who is 16 years old or older can get vaccinated (born in 2005 or earlier). Book your time for vaccination on the website 1177.se. Is there no available time right now? Then the health care may be run out of times just temporarily. New times for reservations will be available as soon as the Health Care Center receives more vaccine doses. Some Health Care Centers also offers drop-in for vaccination at special times where you not need to pre-book.

If you have questions about how to get your vaccination you can call the vaccination help desk at 0480-844 44 (information only in Swedish). Persons under the age of 18 need a consent from their parents or caregiver. A form to fill in for that permission is to find at the website 1177.se.

On-site teaching for children and youngsters

From the autumn term, all teaching will take place on site at the school. When many people gather again at school or at work, there is a risk that the Delta-variant of the coronavirus will spread.

If there is an infection in a school, the public health authority can decide that the teaching should take place from home. Your municipality and school will inform about such decisions.

We must continue to follow these pieces of advice:

- Keep distance from other people, specially indoors.
- Stay at home if you have cold symptoms and if so, always do a covid-19-test
- Even you who are vaccinated should stay at home at symptoms. You can carry the infection even if you feel just a little sick.
- Avoid places where there can be a lot of people
- Only see people you usually meet. If you can, meet outdoors.
- Wash your hands often.
